honjōzō-shu

*Rice polished down to a minimum of 70% and a small amount of brewers alcohol is added. Light-bodied and dry.***Hakkaisan Tokubetsu Honjōzō** Niigata 300 ml | 54

Dry, crisp, and clean with gentle banana bread and baking spice notes.

Urakasumi "Honjikomi" Honjōzō Miyagi 720 ml | 84

versatile, warm banana bread and baking spice with a savoury yet dry palate.

junmai-shu

*Rice can be milled to any percentage so long as it is listed on the label. Full-bodied with pronounced acidity.***Izumi "Arabashiri" First Press Junmai Muroka Nama** Toronto 375ml | 58

Unpasteurized, fresh, bold and fruity with hints of nuttiness.

Hokko Masamune Junmai Nagano 720 ml | 96

Crisp, sharp, refreshing, with a backbone of jack fruit, green banana and umami.

Tedorigawa "U" Yamahai Junmai Ishikawa 720 ml | 100

Elegant ripe pear and melon notes followed by a crisp finish.

Otokoyama 'Man's Mountain' Tokubetsu Junmai Hokkaidō 720 ml | 105

Medium hard brewing water provides a sharp, drying finish to this versatile sake.

Takachiyo "Extra Dry +19" Junmai Niigata 720 ml | 126

Extremely dry with banana bread, apple and mandarin peel.

Kokuryu "Kuzuryu" Junmai Fukui 720 ml | 126

Elegant, dry with subtle umami backbone and notes of ripe banana and fuji apple.

Daijiro "Wataribune No.2" Kimoto Junmai Genshu Shiga 720 ml | 126

Wataribune No.2 is a rare heirloom rice. Savoury, layered and complex.

Daishichi Kimoto Junmai Fukushima 720 ml | 132

Complex with high levels of umami. Shiitake, honey and bruised pear.

Zaku 'Impression G' Junmai Genshu Mie, Japan 720 ml | 136

Melon, green banana and spice with a very easy to drink profile.

Bunkajin 'Karakuchi' Junmai Kochi 720 ml | 140

Bone dry and crisp with notes of green banana and melon.

MACHO 'Gorilla' Koshiki Kimoto Junmai Gunma 720 ml | 145

This sake is part of the MACHO series that explores the power of rice. Made in the ancient kimoto method, this sake is full bodied and oozing with umami.

Yamagata Masamune '1898' Kimoto Junmai Yamagata 720 ml | 150

From one of Japan's top producers. Complex and savoury with a clean, sharp finish.

ginjō-shu

*Rice that has been milled down to 60% of its original size.
Elegant, refined and aromatic.*

Kikusui ‘Fountain of Youth’ Junmai Ginjō Niigata 300 ml | 42

Light and comfortably dry with aromas of fresh cantaloupe, banana, and refreshing Mandarin orange accents.

Kubota ‘Senju’ Ginjō Niigata 300 ml | 54

Classic Niigata style sake, with the region’s signature refreshingly dry palate. Elegant notes of pear and melon with smooth, clean and crisp finish.

Sanran Junmai Ginjō Tochigi, Japan 300 ml | 62

Made with local Yumesasara rice, this award-winning sake exhibits notes of white peach, apple and honeysuckle.

Nanbu Bijin ‘Green’ Junmai Ginjō Iwate, Japan 300 ml | 64

Clean, light, dry, with honeydew, pear and gala apple notes. The medium-hard water to craft this comes from the brewery’s 100-year old well.

Dewazakura ‘Oka’ Ginjō Yamagata, Japan 720 ml | 90

Bright tropical and cherry notes with a lean, dry palate. This famous sake was one of Japan’s first ginjo sakes that consumers could buy in the 1980’s.

Nanbu Bijin ‘Blue’ Ginjō Iwate, Japan 720 ml | 112

Clean, light, dry, with honeydew, jack fruit and apple notes. The medium-hard water to craft this comes from the brewery’s 100-year old well.

Niwa no Uguisu ‘60’ Junmai Ginjō Fukuoka, Japan 720 ml | 125

This food friendly sake has a profile of green melon and stone fruit accents with a crisp, refreshing finish.

Jikon “Omachi” Junmai Ginjō Mie 720 ml | 174

Jikon is one of Japan’s most sought-after brands, particularly known for its small-batch, fruity yet sublimely balanced style. Made with the rare Omachi heirloom rice. Tropical and white flower aromas with a round, clean palate.

Ippakusui “Misato Nishiki” Junmai Ginjō Akita 720 ml | 180

One of Akita’s cult brands. This Junmai Ginjō is made with local Misato Nishiki, which the brewery helped to develop, which has been polished to 50%. Tropical and floral aromas with an intense palate *with* mandarin peel accents.

Hiroki Junmai Ginjō Fukushima 720 ml | 210

Absolutely sublime sake with a delicate profile of honeydew melon, bubblegum and white flowers. The Hiroki is perfectly balanced with a moderate and clean finish.

daiginjō-shu

*Rice has been milled down to less than 50% of its original size.
The pinnacle of the sake brewer's craft.*

Hakutsuru 'Sho-Une' Junmai Daiginjō Hyogo, Japan **300 ml | 50**
Crisp + bone dry with notes of apple, white peach and pear.

Okunomatsu 'Sakura' Daiginjō Fukushima, Japan **300 ml | 56**
Aromatic cherry and green fruit notes with an elegant, balanced and dry palate.

Masumi 'Sanka' Junmai Daiginjō Niigata **300 ml | 60**
'Sanka' means mountain flower in Japanese, referring to the brewery's pristine locale in the Japanese Alps of Nagano.

Keigetsu 'Cel-24' Junmai Daiginjō Kochi **720 ml | 120**
Made with one of the most aromatic yeasts in the sake world, bursting with a unique floral and tropical fruit profile.

Wakatake 'Limited Edition' Junmai Daiginjō Shizuoka **720 ml | 125**
From the waters of southern Mount Fuji and local rice cultivated in its shadow. Elegant aromas of melon, green banana and a clean, dry finish.

Dassai '23' Junmai Daiginjō Yamaguchi **300 ml | 128**
Dassai is a cult sake brand in Japan known for only making premium Daiginjo sake. Using high quality Yamada Nishiki rice, polished down to 23% of its original size, this sake possesses a very elegant palate with tropical and cucumber notes.

Kuheiji 'Kanochi' Junmai Daiginjō Aichi **720 ml | 130**
Kuheiji is all about producing fine junmai daiginjo in an elegant and food-friendly way. The Kanochi is made with top grade Yamada Nishiki rice polished down to 40%. Notes of melon, jack fruit and bubblegum.

SŌTŌ Junmai Daiginjō Niigata **720 ml | 132**
Clean, crisp and dry with subtle hints of gala apple, lychee and cucumber notes.

Dassai '45' Junmai Daiginjō Yamaguchi **720 ml | 148**
One of Japan's cult Daiginjo producers, Asahi Shuzo (the brewery behind the Dassai brand), only makes Junmai Daiginjo sakes. This is bursting with tropical fruit aromas and a very balanced palate of fruit and floral notes, with a luscious, silky texture.

Masumi 'Nanago' Junmai Daiginjō Nagano 720 ml | 215

One of Nagano's oldest and most esteemed breweries. This sake is made using pristine water from the Japanese Alps that literally surround the brewery. Made with famous house yeast No.7 ('nanago') the brewery isolated in the 1940's.

Raifuku 'Betsuaturae' Junmai Daiginjō Ibaraki 720 ml | 250

Made with Aiyama rice polished to 29%, this is a silky melon sake with aromas of guava cherries, key lime pie, passion fruit and a pleasant long lasting finish.

Yamagata Masamune 'Kikujin' Junmai Daiginjō Yamagata 720 ml | 345

Brewed using the Kimoto method with 100% Grade A Yamada Nishiki rice from the Akitsu region in Hyogo prefecture. Aged for 2 years before release. Floral and aromatic, while dry and crisp on the palate due to hard water.

Shiraiwa 'IWA 5' Assemblage Toyama 720 ml | 375

Richard Geoffrey's (former Cellar Master of Dom Perignon) new project. A blend of more than 17 individual sakes, this 'assemblage' has complexity, depth and tension.

KID 'Muryozan 35' Junmai Daiginjō Wakayama 720 ml | 650

Made with Grand Cru Yamada Nishiki rice polished down to 35%, this sake is extremely elegant and savour-worthy. It is a tribute to the Muryozan temple where Heiwa Shuzo first started making sake in 1928.

nigori

Roughly filtered or 'cloudy'. Textured and creamy on the palate, with flavours of coconut and tropical fruit.

Hakutsuru 'Sayuri' Nigori Hyogo 300 ml | 36

Japan's No.1 selling nigori-zake! Melon, coconut with a silky mouthfeel and sharp, crisp finish.

Dassai '45' Junmai Daiginjō Sasa-Nigori Yamaguchi 300 ml | 68

A quintessential Daiginjō sake from one of Japan's cult breweries. Melon, banana + bubblegum lead to savoury jackfruit flavours on the palate.

Tengumai Yamahai Nigori Ishikawa 720 ml | 120

This is a savoury yet crisp nigori with a silky texture and lifting acidity. This yamahai has plenty of body, and the mineral rich water used to brew it provide a cleansing sharpness on the finish.

Ryusei 'Katsudaku' Active Nigori Hiroshima 720 ml | 140

This sake is both sparkling and unfiltered, made by leaving the sake unpasteurized and allowing it to continue fermenting in the bottle.

sparkling sake

Typically low alcohol and off-dry.

Mio Sparkling Junmai Nada 300 ml | 44

Bright + fruity with a refreshing palate of cream soda and fresh stone fruit.

Ninki Sparkling Junmai Ginjō Fukushima 300 ml | 58

Made using the secondary bottle fermentation that is used to make Champagne. This low alcohol sake has a hint of sweet fruit balanced by lively effervescence.

Hakkaisan 'Awa' Sparkling Junmai Daiginjo Niigata 360 ml | 110

Dry and crisp with a persistent effervescence. Made in the Traditional Method.

Ryusei 'Katsudaku' Active Nigori Hiroshima 720 ml | 140

This sake is both sparkling and unfiltered, made by leaving the sake unpasteurized and allowing it to continue fermenting in the bottle.

fruit infused sake

Tsukasabotan 'Yama Yuzu' Shibori Kochi 720 ml | 85

Lively citrus flavours with mandarin spice undertones from high quality yuzu fruit.

Amabuki 'Matcha Yuzu' Sake Saga 720 ml | 110

Made with matcha tea from the famous Uji region of Kyoto and high quality yuzu fruit, an aromatic citrus fruit. Luscious and honeyed on the palate.

Nanbu Bijin 'No Sugar Added' Umesu Iwate 720 ml | 110

This sake is made with the brewery's own secretive formula to create natural sugars during fermentation and blended with high quality Japanese plums from Wakayama.
