## sake by the bottle

**H o n j ō z o - s h u** rice polished down to a minimum of 70% and a small amount of brewers alcohol is added. light-bodied + dry.

**Kaiun “New Fortune Iwaizake” Tokubetsu Honjōzō 300ml | 40**

soft, fruity and very easy-to-drink, typical of the Shizuoka sake style. This brewery lies at the feet of Mount Fuji and the Akaishi southern Alps.

**J u n m a i - s h u** rice can be milled to any percentage so long as it is listed on the label. full-bodied with pronounced acidity.

**Izumi “Arabashiri” First Press Junmai Muroka Nama Toronto 375ml | 48**

unpasteurized, fresh, bold + fruity with hints of nuttiness. Izumi means spring water in Japanese, referring to the fresh Huntsville water used to make it.

**Hata Shuzo “Daijuro” Junmai Shiga 300 ml | 50**

From one of the smallest craft breweries on the ki list comes this versatile junmai, bursting with fresh banana bread and warm spice aromas and a delicate umami palate.

**Fukumitsuya “Kazeyo Mizuho Hitoyo” Junmai Ishikawa 300 ml | 52**

From one of Ishikawa’s oldest sake breweries. This Junmai is designed with food in mind, and brewed using its own proprietary sake yeasts.

**Mutsuhassen Tokubetsu Junmai Aomori, Japan 300 ml | 56**

Honeydew, pineapple + honeyblossom notes with a clean, balanced palate.

**Dewazakura ‘Dewanosato’ Junmai Yamagata 720 ml | 88**

IWC 2016 winner. made with local dewanosato rice, this versatile sake has green apple + spice notes with a rich + soft palate.

**Yoshidagura ‘U’ Yamahai Junmai Ishikawa 720 ml | 90**

Drawing from the famous groundwater from Mt. Haku, one of Japan’s most revered mountains. This sake has depth and complexity with a sharp, crisp backbone of acidity and texture that will make you want more!

**Otokoyama ‘Man’s Mountain’ Tokubetsu Junmai Hokkaidō 500 ml | 92**

Made by one of Japan’s most northernmost sake breweries. The brewing water is medium hard, providing a sharp, drying finish to this extremely versatile sake.

**Moriki Shuzo ‘Rumiko’s Sake’ Tokubetsu Junmai Mie 720 ml | 96**

This versatile sake is brewed by a woman Toji, Rumiko. A label is drawn by Akira Oze, famous for the comic ‘Natsuko’s Sake’. The sake is made using the classic Kyokai No. 9 yeast with sharp spiciness and umami.

**Ohyama ‘Tomizu’ Tokubetsu Junmai Yamagata 720 ml | 98**

full + savoury with notes of white grape, pear and fresh herbs.

## sake by the bottle

### **Hanatomoe 'Mizumoto' Junmai Muroka Genshu** Nara **720 ml | 115**

made the way sake was made in 16th century Japan, called *bodaimoto*. This is savoury, full with aromas of fresh cheddar, warm spices + bruised apple.

### **Tenmei 'Orange' Junmai** Fukushima, Japan **720 ml | 98**

The brewers behind Tenmei love to explore unique sake making methods, from blending many rice strains in a single fermentation tank to using their own house yeasts. This Junmai is made by blending four sake rice strains to achieve the perfect flavours, umami and balance.

### **Mimurosuji 'Tsuyuhakaze Dry' Junmai** Nara, Japan **720 ml | 110**

Made with local Tsuyuhakaze rice, this cult sake is made by Imanishi Brewery, established in 1660. The trademark of this sake is a mouth-filling umami, savoury palate that sharply finishes clean and dry.

### **Taiheizan "Shingetsu" Kimoto Junmai** Akita **720 ml | 122**

A sublime kimoto made with the pristine waters of the Shirakami mountains in Northern Akita, a UNESCO World Heritage site. The water is filtered through Japan's largest beech tree forests and made in the unique 'Akita-ryu Kimoto' method that involved a gigantic drill bit to mash the rice.

### **Makino Shuzo 'Macho Masked' Junmai** Gunma **720 ml | 128**

Part of the ever popular Macho series, the unmasked hides the name of the sake rice used. This muscular sake is bursting with umami, ripe banana and pear notes.

### **Tomita Shuzo 'Shichihonyari' Organic Muu Junmai** Shiga **720 ml | 138**

The breweries in Shiga are all about harnessing rice's rich and umami-laden flavours. They are also focussed on sustainability and taking care of their land. Thus, this Junmai is made with organic and local sake rice. The result is layers of flavours from gala apple and bartlett pear to warm baking spices to freshly steamed rice.

*Ginjō-shu* rice that has been milled down to 60% of its original size. elegant, refined + aromatic.

### **Zaku "Miyabi no Tomo" Junmai Ginjō** Mie, Japan **300 ml | 56**

Gold medal winner. Bursting with green apple crispness and tropical fruit flavours.

### **Masumi 'Kuro' Junmai Ginjō** Nagano, Japan **720 ml | 98**

clean, crisp + dry with green banana aromas. Masumi is the highest elevation brewery in all of Japan, located high up in the Japanese Alps.

### **Dewazakura 'Omachi' Junmai Ginjō** Yamagata, Japan **720 ml | 110**

layered + savoury notes of apple, melon and jack fruit laced with an herbal backbone. made with Omachi, Japan's oldest heirloom sake rice.

### **Yoshi no Gawa 'Goku Jo' Ginjō** Niigata, Japan **720 ml | 110**

clean, light, dry, with orange peel + fennel notes. Niigata sake is renowned for its tanrei karakuchi style - light, crisp + dry.

### **Mutsuhassen 'BLACK' Junmai Ginjō** Aomori, Japan **720 ml | 115**

Ultra modern + clean with flavours of fresh apple, melon and a hint of lychee nut.

### **Jikon 'Omachi' Junmai Ginjō** Mie, Japan **720 ml | 130**

this rare gem from cult brewery Kiyasho Shuzo is made with Omachi, the oldest heirloom rice used for sake making. Expect layers of tropical fruits and hints of spice on the nose with layers of earthy flavours on the palate.

## *Daiginjō-shu*

*rice has been milled down to less than 50% of its original size. the pinnacle of the sake brewer's craft.*

### **Hakutsuru 'Sho-Une' Junmai Daiginjō** Hyogo, Japan **300 ml | 44**

crisp + bone dry with notes of apple, white peach + pear.

### **Masumi 'Sanka' Junmai Daiginjō** Nagano, Japan **300 ml | 54**

'Sanka' means mountain flower in Japanese, referring to the brewery's pristine locale in the Japanese Alps of Nagano. made with Japan's top sake rice called Yamada Nishiki.

### **Heiwa Shuzo 'KID' Junmai Daiginjō** Wakayama, Japan **720 ml | 120**

Located in Japan's fruit capital of Wakayama, this brewery is helmed by a young brewing team that has been turning heads with their pure, fruit-driven sakes. This is the 2020 Brewery of the Year with the International Wine Challenge.

### **Wakatake 'Ltd. Edition' Homare Fuji Junmai Daiginjō** Shizuoka **720 ml | 125**

from the waters of southern Mount Fuji and local rice cultivated in its shadow. elegant aromas of melon, green banana and a clean, dry finish.

### **Tatenokawa 'Phoenix' Junmai Daiginjō** Yamagata **720 ml | 132**

delicate floral + fruity characteristics intermingled with Yamagata's signature savoury qualities from using the local Dewasansan rice.

**Dassai '45' Junmai Daiginjō Yamaguchi 720 ml | 135**

One of Japan's cult Daiginjo producers, Asahi Shuzo (the brewery behind the Dassai brand), only makes Junmai Daiginjo sakes. This is bursting with tropical fruit aromas and a very balanced palate of fruit + floral notes, with a luscious, silky texture.

**Masumi 'Nanago' Junmai Daiginjō Nagano 720 ml | 220**

One of Nagano's oldest and most esteemed breweries. This sake is made using pristine Alps waters from the mountains that literally surround the brewery. Made with famous house yeast No.7 ('nanago') the brewery isolated in the 1940's.

**Kamikawa Taisetsu 'Suisei' Junmai Daiginjō Hokkaidō 720 ml | 230**

From one of Japan's smallest and northernmost sake breweries, using only local sake rice and ingredients. The master brewery, Kawabata-sensei, is a sake rock star in Japan and helped to design this modern brewery. Made with Suisei rice, this sake is opulent, balanced and textured. Look out for Kawabata-sensei's trademark 'shibumi' texture, a pleasant astringency found on the finish.

**Yamakawa Mitsuo 'Lamb' Junmai Daiginjō Yamagata 720 ml | 250**

This sake is part of a collaboration amongst five of Yamagata's most esteemed sake breweries. It is made with local Dewasansan rice polished down to 50% of its original size and the famed medium-hard water from Yamagata Masamune.

**Hakkaisan 'Kongoshin' Junmai Daiginjō Niigata 800 ml | 610**

'kongoshin' means unwavering heart in Japanese. this extremely rare bottling is made with top quality yamada nishiki rice polished down to 40% and aged for more than two years at sub-zero temperatures to give it complexity.

*Nigori roughly filtered or 'cloudy'. textured and creamy on the palate, with flavours of coconut and tropical fruit.*

**Hakutsuru 'Sayuri' Nigori Hyogo 300 ml | 30**

Japan's No.1 seeling nigori-zake! Melon, coconut with a silky mouthfeel + sharp, crisp finish.

**Kikusui 'Perfect Snow' Nigori Niigata 300 ml | 50**

big, bold + chewy, possessing notes of melon, pear and steamed rice.

**Dassai '45' Junmai Daiginjō Nigori Yamaguchi 300 ml | 56**

Bubblegum, pineapple + fresh melon with an elegantly textured palate. This is the lightest 'cloudy' sake at ki.

**Momokawa 'Pearl' Junmai Ginjō Nigori Oregon 750 ml | 62**

the piña colada of sake. notes of coconut, pineapple + banana.

**Niwa no Uguisu 'Unfiltered' Doburoku Fukuoka 720 ml | 96**

Doburoku is an unfiltered sake that was home-brewed among rice farmers until the late 1800s. It is brewed using the same ingredients as sake but the mash is not filtered. The result is a thick, creamy, yogurt-like sweetness with a bright acidity.

*Sparkling Sake typically low alcohol + off dry.*

**Mio Sparkling Junmai Nada 300 ml | 40**

bright + fruity with a refreshing palate of cream soda + fresh stone fruit.

**Hideyoshi 'Lachamte' Sparkling Junmai Akita 280 ml | 45**

Lively notes of white peaches and honeysuckle that are underscored by hints of toasted almonds.

**Akitora 'White Tiger' Sparkling Junmai Ginjō Kochi 330 ml | 48**

Made using a secondary bottle fermentation (like the sparkling wines of the Champagne region). This sparkling is made in Kochi's signature style: dry with fruity aromatics.

**Mutsuhassen 'Natural Sec' Sparkling Junmai Aomori 500 ml | 110**

This mildly dry sparkling is made with local Hanafubuki rice and undergoes a secondary fermentation in bottle (like Champagne) to create fine bubbles.

**SakeOne 'Moonstone' Plum-Infused Junmai Ginjō Oregon 750 ml | 44**

bold yet approachable fruit flavours combined perfectly with laced hints of citrus.

**Tsukasabotan 'Yama Yuzu' Shibori Kochi 720 ml | 85**

lively citrus flavours with mandarin spice undertones from high quality yuzu fruit.
