Kaiun "New Fortune" Tokubetsu Honjōzō Shizuoka **300 ml | 44**
soft, fruity and very easy-to-drink, typical of the Shizuoka sake style. This brewery lies at the feet of Mount Fuji and the Akaishi southern Alps.

J u n m a i - s h u rice can be milled to any percentage so long as it is listed on the label. full-bodied with pronounced acidity.

Izumi "Arabashiri" First Press Junmai Muroka Nama Toronto **375ml | 48**
unpasteurized, fresh, bold + fruity with hints of nuttiness. Izumi means spring water in Japanese, referring to the fresh Huntsville water used to make it.

Narukomai "Deep Sea Space" Junmai Kochi **300 ml | 50**
This unique sake is made with yeast that has been to outer space (no kidding) and then stored a 6000 metres below the Pacific ocean, in a survival of the fittest experiment. It possesses herbal notes of sasparrilla, ripe banana and a pronounced richness.

Nanbu Bijin "Red Label" Tokubetsu Junmai Iwate **300 ml | 52**
This is a Gold Medal winner at the International Wine Challenge, the world's largest sake challenge. It possesses the perfect balance between savoury cereal notes and fruit (apple, pear and green banana).

Hyakujuro "Red Face Extra Dry" Junmai Gifu **300 ml | 55**
Named after famous kabuki actor from Gifu, Hyakujuro Ichikawa, and helmed by one of Japan's few female sake brewers, Reiko Hayashi, This bone dry sake is incredibly versatile, possessing notes of lime peel, white flower and fresh steamed rice.

Emishiki "Sensation White" Tokubetsu Junmai Shiga **720 ml | 88**
Established along the ancient Tokaido, Japan's first road, this brewery is nothing but modern in its philosophies. Aromas and flavours of citrus, grapes, banana + ripe red apple.

Tedorigawa Yamahai Junmai Ishikawa **720 ml | 90**
Drawing from the famous groundwater from Mt. Haku, one of Japan's most revered mountains. This sake has depth and complexity with a sharp, crisp backbone of acidity and texture that will make you want more!

Otokoyama 'Man's Mountain' Tokubetsu Junmai Hokkaidō **500 ml | 92**
Made by one of Japan's most northernmost sake breweries. The brewing water is medium hard, providing a sharp, drying finish to this extremely versatile sake.

Mutsuhassen 'Red' Tokubetsu Junmai Aomori, Japan **720 ml | 110**
Modern and vibrant with a collection of notes of collection of red apple, grape, blueberry + mango aromas.

Taiheizan "Shingetsu" Kimoto Junmai Akita **720 ml | 122**
Made with the pristine waters of the Shirakami mountains in Northern Akita, a UNESCO World Heritage site where the water is filtered through Japan's largest beech tree forests. Made in the unique 'Akita-ryu Kimoto' method that involved a gigantic drill bit to mash the rice.

Daishichi Kimoto Junmai Fukushima, Japan **720 ml | 125**
Established in 1752, Daishichi has a long standing tradition of crafting sakes in the ancient Kimoto method. This leads to complexity, high levels of umami and a sake that is extremely versatile (try it chilled or warm).

Zaku 'Impression H' Junmai Genshu Mie, Japan **720 ml | 130**
Hailing from the land of the ninja, the Zaku brand has won multiple awards for its fruit-forward style. The rare Impression series is made using new proprietary technology that maximizes freshness. It's like drinking unpasteurized sake right at the brewery!

Yamagata Masamune "1898" Kimoto Junmai Yamagata **720 ml | 132**
Made with the cult rice Omachi from the top paddies of Akaiwa, Okayama. This sake is rich, layered with an exotic backbone of tree fruit and warm spices.

Niida Honke "Shizenshu" Junmai Genshu Fukushima 720 ml | 135

This is Japan's first brewery to commit to organic practices and natural sak fermentation. They almost exclusively use the ancient kimoto method in crafting their sakes, and utilize the hard waters from the Abukuma Plateau.

Tomita Shuzo 'Shichihonyari' Organic Muu Junmai Shiga 720 ml | 138

This Junmai is made with organic and local sake rice. The result is layers of flavours from gala apple and bartlett pear to warm baking spices to freshly steamed rice.

Ginjō-shu rice that has been milled down to 60% of its original size. elegant, refined + aromatic.

Bunkajin "Matsuyama Mitsui" Junmai Ginjō Kochi, Japan 300 ml | 54

Kochi sake is known for its bright, fresh and dry style. This sake is no exception! Yellow banana, cream soda and green melon notes with a crisp, refreshingly dry palate.

Zaku Junmai Ginjō Mie, Japan 300 ml | 65

Bright, clean and floral, with aromas of melon, apple + subtle lychee accents.

Okunomatsu Junmai Ginjō Genshu Arabashiri Fukushima 720 ml | 85

With more than 300-years of sake making and a family connected to the samurai, Okunomatsu knows how to make great sake. This Junmai Ginjo is free run sake (arabashiri), a type of sake rare to see in Canada.

Hakurou Junmai Ginjō Aichi, Japan 720 ml | 95

made with local Aichi-grown Yume Ginga rice polished to 55% of its original size. fruity, elegant and extremely versatile when it comes to pairing with food.

Masumi 'Kuro' Junmai Ginjō Nagano, Japan 720 ml | 102

clean, crisp + dry with green banana aromas. Masumi is the highest elevation brewery in all of Japan, located high up in the Japanese Alps.

Nanbu Bijin 'Blue' Ginjō Iwate, Japan 720 ml | 105

clean, light, dry, with honeydew, jack fruit and apple notes. The medium-hard water to craft this comes from the brewery's 100-year old well.

Tenmei 'Black' Junmai Ginjō Fukushima, Japan 720 ml | 110

The brewers behind Tenmei love to explore unique sake making methods, from blending many rice strains in a single fermentation tank to using their own house yeasts. The Tenmei Black is made by blending prefectural 'dream' yeast F7-01 with their own proprietary 'katsuki' yeast. The result is a sake with tropical lychee aromas and a very light palate.

Mutsuhassen 'Pink' Ginjō Aomori, Japan 720 ml | 120

Ultra modern + clean with flavours of fresh apple, melon and a hint of lychee nut.

Bunkajin 'Omachi' Junmai Ginjō Kōchi 720 ml | 145

Made with Japan's oldest sake rice, Omachi. Bursting with aromas of jack fruit + mandarin peel with a pleasant dry, textured finish.

Daiginjō-shu

rice has been milled down to less than 50% of its original size. the pinnacle of the sake brewer's craft.

Hakutsuru 'Sho-Une' Junmai Daiginjō Hyogo, Japan 300 ml | 44

crisp + bone dry with notes of apple, white peach + pear.

Masumi 'Sanka' Junmai Daiginjō Niigata 300 ml | 52

'Sanka' means mountain flower in Japanese, referring to the brewery's pristine locale in the Japanese Alps of Nagano. made with Japan's top sake rice called Yamada Nishiki.

Dassai '23' Junmai Daiginjō Niigata 300 ml | 108

Dassai is a cult sake brand in Japan known for only making premium Daiginjo sake. using high quality Yamada Nishiki rice, polished down to 23% of its original size, this sake possesses a very elegant palate with layers of tropical fruit + cucumber aromas.

Hakurou 'Tojo Yamada Nishiki' Junmai Daiginjō Alchi 720 ml | 110

this small brewery is all about hand-made, tradition sake making. made with some of the most sought after Yamada Nishiki rice from the village of Tojo, this sake is crisp, subtly fruity with layered richness.

Miyoshikiku 'Ayane' Junmai Daiginjō Tokushima 720 ml | 115

Ayane is one of Master Brewer Mamiya Ryōichirō's daughters who helped make the sake. The ingredients are all local, using Tokushima Yamada nishiki rice, brewing water from a mountain spring, and a rare local blue LED sake yeast.

Miyakanbai Junmai Daiginjo, Miyagi 720 ml | 120

this mellow sake has an elegant profile of berry, peach, melon with hints of honey.

Wakatake 'Limited Edition' Junmai Daiginjō Shizuoka 720 ml | 125

from the waters of southern Mount Fuji and local rice cultivated in its shadow. elegant aromas of melon, green banana and a clean, dry finish.

SŌTŌ Junmai Daiginjō Niigata 720 ml | 128

clean, crisp + dry with subtle hints of gala apple, lychee and cucumber notes.

Tatenokawa 'Phoenix' Junmai Daiginjō Yamagata 720 ml | 132

delicate floral + fruity characteristics intermingled with Yamagata's signature savoury qualities from using the local Dewasansan rice.

Dassai '45' Junmai Daiginjō Yamaguchi 720 ml | 140

One of Japan's cult Daiginjo producers, Asahi Shuzo (the brewery behind the Dassai brand), only makes Junmai Daiginjo sakes. This is bursting with tropical fruit aromas and a very balanced palate of fruit + floral notes, with a luscious, silky texture.

Masumi 'Nanago' Junmai Daiginjō Nagano 720 ml | 200

One of Nagano's oldest and most esteemed breweries. This sake is made using pristine water from the Japanese Alps that literally surround the brewery. Made with famous house yeast No.7 ('nanago') the brewery isolated in the 1940's.

Kamikawa Taisetsu 'Suisei' Junmai Daiginjō Hokkaidō 720 ml | 230

The 2nd northernmost brewery in Japan and one of the sake world's newest breweries, helmed by famous Kawabata-Toji. Made with Suisei, a local rice known for its light flavours and elegant aromatics of green apple.

Yamakawa Mitsuo 'Lamb' Junmai Daiginjō Yamagata 720 ml | 250

This sake is part of a collaboration amongst five of Yamagata's most esteemed sake breweries. It is made with local Dewasansan rice polished down to 50% of its original size and the famed medium-hard water from Yamagata Masamune.

Daishichi 'Minowamon' Kimoto Junmai Daiginjō Fukushima 720 ml | 260

This is a connoisseur's sake! Daishichi is one of the few sake breweries who are capable of crafting Junmai Daiginjo sake in the kimoto method, a very labour intensive process. The Minowamon has flavours of ripe pear, bananas, and mangos with a solid backbone of acidity and umami.

Yamagata Masamune 'Ai' Junmai Daiginjō Yamagata 720 ml | 345

Brewed using the Kimoto method with 100% Grade A Omachi rice from Akaiwa region in Okayama. Aged for 2 years before release. Beautiful notes of melon and fresh apples balanced with subtle pine and herbaceousness.

Yamagata Masamune 'Kikujin' Junmai Daiginjō Yamagata 720 ml | 345

Brewed using the Kimoto method with 100% Grade A Yamada Nishiki rice from the Akitsu region in Hyogo prefecture. Aged for 2 years before release. Floral and aromatic, while dry and crisp on the palate due to hard water.

KID 'Muryozan 35' Junmai Daiginjō Wakayama 720 ml | 650

Made with Grand Cru Yamada Nishiki rice polished down to 35%, this sake is extremely elegant and savour-worthy. This sake is a tribute to the Muryozan temple where Heiwa Shuzo first started making sake in 1928.

Nigori roughly filtered or 'cloudy', textured and creamy on the palate, with flavours of coconut and tropical fruit.

Hakutsuru 'Sayuri' Nigori Hyogo 300 ml | 30

Japan's No.1 seeling nigori-zake! Melon, coconut with a silky mouthfeel + sharp, crisp finish.

Kikusui 'Perfect Snow' Nigori Genshu Niigata 300 ml | 45

big, bold + chewy, possessing notes of melon, pear and steamed rice.

Momokawa 'Pearl' Junmai Ginjō Nigori Oregon 750 ml | 64

the piña colada of sake. notes of coconut, pineapple + banana.

Dassai '45' Junmai Daiginjō Sasa-Nigori Yamaguchi 300 ml | 66

a quintessential Daiginjō sake from one of Japan's cult breweries. melon, banana + fuji apple lead to savoury jackfruit flavours on the palate.

Yamagata Masamune Junmai Ginjō Sasa-Nigori Yamagata 720 ml | 88

tropical fruit + lychee aromas with a clean, sharp and dry finish.

Sparkling Sake typically low alcohol + off dry.

Mio Sparkling Junmai Nada 300 ml | 40

bright + fruity with a refreshing palate of cream soda + fresh stone fruit.

Hideyoshi 'Lachamte' Sparkling Junmai Akita 280 ml | 45

Lively notes of white peaches and honeysuckle that are underscored by hints of toasted almonds.

Akitora 'White Tiger' Sparkling Junmai Ginjō Kochi 330 ml | 48

Made using a secondary bottle fermentation (like the sparkling wines of the Champagne region). This sparkling is made in Kochi's signature style: dry with fruity aromatics.

Ninki Sparkling Junmai Ginjō Fukushima 720 ml | 85

Made using the secondary bottle fermentation that is used to make Champagne. This low alcohol sake has a hint of sweet fruit balanced by lively effervescence.

KID Nama Junmai Daiginjō Sparkling Wakayama 360 ml | 88

Bright, fruity and ultra clean! From the award-winning brewery of the year, Heiwa Shuzo.

Mutsuhassen 'Natural Sec' Sparkling Junmai Aomori 500 ml | 110

This mildly dry sparkling is made with local Hanafubuki rice and undergoes a secondary fermentation in bottle (like Champagne) to create fine bubbles.

Fruit Infused Sake**SakeOne 'Moonstone' Plum-Infused Junmai Ginjō Oregon 750 ml | 44**

bold yet approachable fruit flavours combined perfectly with laced hints of citrus.

Tsukasabotan 'Yama Yuzu' Shibori Kochi 720 ml | 85

lively citrus flavours with mandarin spice undertones from high quality yuzu fruit.
