**H o n j ō z ō - s h u** rice polished down to a minimum of 70% and a small amount of brewers alcohol is added. light-bodied + dry.

**Kaiun "New Fortune" Tokubetsu Honjōzō** Shizuoka **300 ml | 45**  
soft, fruity and very easy-to-drink, typical of the Shizuoka sake style. This brewery lies at the feet of Mount Fuji and the Akaishi southern Alps.

**J u n m a i - s h u** rice can be milled to any percentage so long as it is listed on the label. full-bodied with pronounced acidity.

**Izumi "Arabashiri" First Press Junmai Muroka Nama** Toronto **375ml | 50**  
unpasteurized, fresh, bold + fruity with hints of nuttiness. Izumi means spring water in Japanese, referring to the fresh Huntsville water used to make it.

**Narukomai "Deep Sea Space" Junmai** Kochi **300 ml | 52**  
Made with yeast that has been to outer space (no kidding) and then stored at 6000 metres below the Pacific ocean, in a survival of the fittest experiment. It possesses herbal notes of sasparilla, ripe banana and a pronounced richness.

**Hyakujuro "Red Mask" Extra Dry Junmai** Gifu **300 ml | 57**  
Named after a famous kabuki actor from Gifu, Hyakujuro Ichikawa, and helmed by one of Japan's few female sake brewers, Reiko Hayashi. Bone dry and incredibly versatile with notes of lime peel, white flower and fresh steamed rice.

**Tedorigawa "U" Yamahai Junmai** Ishikawa **720 ml | 94**  
This sake is made using the famous Hakusan - Tedoru River water system that is said to take 100 years to make its into the brewery's ground water. This sake has elegant ripe pear and melon notes followed by a crisp finish.

**Otokoyama 'Man's Mountain' Tokubetsu Junmai** Hokkaidō **500 ml | 94**  
Made by one of Japan's most northernmost sake breweries. The brewing water is medium hard, providing a sharp, drying finish to this extremely versatile sake.

**Nabeshima "Akaiwa Omachi" Tokubetsu Junmai** Saga **720 ml | 110**  
Akaiwa Omachi is the oldest heirloom sake rice in Japan that is cultivated in its most famous 'Grand Cru' region. This is a modern style sake with a hint of effervescence from one of Saga's preeminent sake breweries.

**Terada Honke "Katori 90" Junmai** Chiba **720 ml | 110**  
Katori is an old merchant town along the Tone river used to transport goods during to Edo (Tokyo). Savoury with hints of baked apple and warm spices.

**Daishichi Kimoto Junmai** Fukushima **720 ml | 125**  
Established in 1752, Daishichi has a long standing tradition of crafting sakes in the ancient Kimoto method. This leads to complexity, high levels of umami and a sake that is extremely versatile (try it chilled or warm).

**G i n j ō - s h u** rice that has been milled down to 60% of its original size. elegant, refined + aromatic.

**Bunkajin "Matsuyama Mii" Junmai Ginjō** Kochi, Japan **300 ml | 50**  
Kochi sake is known for its bright, fresh and dry style. This sake is no exception! Yellow banana, cream soda and green melon notes with a crisp, refreshingly dry palate.

**Gangi "Mizunowa" Junmai Ginjō** Yamaguchi, Japan **300 ml | 55**  
Tropical notes of pineapple + honeydew melon with a very easy-to-drink profile. Mizunowa refers to the rippling waves that form when fish leap from the river surface.

**Nanbu Bijin 'Green' Junmai Ginjō** Iwate, Japan **300 ml | 60**  
clean, light, dry, with honeydew, pear and gala apple notes. The medium-hard water to craft this comes from the brewery's 100-year old well.

**Zaku Junmai Ginjō** Mie, Japan **300 ml | 65**  
Bright, clean and floral, with aromas of melon, apple + subtle lychee accents.

**Dewazakura 'Oka' Ginjō** Yamagata, Japan 720 ml | 84

Bright tropical and cherry notes with a lean, dry palate. This famous sake was one of Japan's first ginjō sakes that consumers could buy in the 1980's.

**Heiwa Shuzo 'KID' Junmai Ginjō** Wakayama, Japan 720 ml | 105

Heiwa Shuzo has been garnering awards for the past several years, crafting sake that reflects the landscape, climate and raw materials Wakayama. This sake is light and floral and bursting with guava and citrus accents and a bright, juicy palate.

**Nanbu Bijin 'Blue' Ginjō** Iwate, Japan 720 ml | 106

clean, light, dry, with honeydew, jack fruit and apple notes. The medium-hard water to craft this comes from the brewery's 100-year old well.

**Mutsuhassen 'Pink' Ginjō** Aomori, Japan 720 ml | 120

Ultra modern + clean with flavours of fresh apple, melon and a hint of lychee nut.

**Senkin "Modern Omachi" Junmai Ginjō** Tochigi 720 ml | 136

From the Usui brothers who explore the idea of terroir in sake. The rice is local, organically-grown Omachi, Japan's oldest heirloom rice. This sake has a subtle nose of white peach, honeydew and jack fruit, with a sensational mouth-watering acidity that makes it perfect with our signature cold plates.

**Jikon "Omachi" Junmai Ginjō** Mie 720 ml | 145

Jikon is one of Japan's most sought-after brands, particularly for its small-batch, fruity yet extremely balanced style. Made with the rare Omachi heirloom rice. Tropical and white flower aromas with a round, clean palate.

## Daiginjō-shu

*rice has been milled down to less than 50% of its original size. the pinnacle of the sake brewer's craft.*

**Hakutsuru 'Sho-Une' Junmai Daiginjō** Hyogo, Japan 300 ml | 44

crisp + bone dry with notes of apple, white peach + pear.

**Kubota 'Black Label' Junmai Daiginjō** Niigata 300 ml | 48

This is classic Niigata-style sake, with the region's signature crisp + dry palate. Elegant notes of pear + melon with smooth, clean + crisp flavor flavours.

**Okunomatsu 'Sakura' Daiginjō** Fukushima, Japan 300 ml | 52

aromatic cherry + green fruit notes with an elegant, balanced palate on this perennial favourite!

**Masumi 'Sanka' Junmai Daiginjō** Niigata 300 ml | 55

'Sanka' means mountain flower in Japanese, referring to the brewery's pristine locale in the Japanese Alps of Nagano. made with Japan's top sake rice called Yamada Nishiki.

**Wakatake 'Limited Edition' Junmai Daiginjō** Shizuoka 720 ml | 125

from the waters of southern Mount Fuji and local rice cultivated in its shadow. elegant aromas of melon, green banana and a clean, dry finish.

**SŌTŌ Junmai Daiginjō** Niigata 720 ml | 128

clean, crisp + dry with subtle hints of gala apple, lychee and cucumber notes.

**Tatenokawa 'Phoenix' Junmai Daiginjō** Yamagata 720 ml | 132

delicate floral + fruity characteristics intermingled with Yamagata's signature savoury qualities from using the local Dewasansan rice.

**Dassai '45' Junmai Daiginjō** Yamaguchi 720 ml | 140

One of Japan's cult Daiginjo producers, Asahi Shuzo (the brewery behind the Dassai brand), only makes Junmai Daiginjo sakes. This is bursting with tropical fruit aromas and a very balanced palate of fruit + floral notes, with a luscious, silky texture.

**Masumi 'Nanago' Junmai Daiginjō** Nagano 720 ml | 200

One of Nagano's oldest and most esteemed breweries. This sake is made using pristine water from the Japanese Alps that literally surround the brewery. Made with famous house yeast No.7 ('nanago') the brewery isolated in the 1940's.

**Kamikawa Taisetsu 'Suisei' Junmai Daiginjō** Hokkaidō 720 ml | 230

The 2nd northernmost brewery in Japan and one of the sake world's newest breweries, helmed by famous Kawabata-Toji. Made with Suisei, a local rice known for its light flavours and elegant aromatics of green apple.

**Daishichi 'Minowamon' Kimoto Junmai Daiginjō** Fukushima 720 ml | 260

This is a connoisseur's sake! Daishichi is one of the few sake breweries who are capable of crafting Junmai Daiginjo sake in the kimoto method, a very labour intensive process. The Minowamon has flavours of ripe pear, bananas and mangos with a solid backbone of acidity and umami.

**Yamagata Masamune 'AI' Junmai Daiginjō** Yamagata 720 ml | 345

Brewed using the Kimoto method with 100% Grade A Omachi rice from Akaiwa region in Okayama. Aged for 2 years before release. Beautiful notes of melon and fresh apples balanced with subtle pine and herbaceousness.

**Yamagata Masamune 'Kikujin' Junmai Daiginjō** Yamagata 720 ml | 345

Brewed using the Kimoto method with 100% Grade A Yamada Nishiki rice from the Akitsu region in Hyogo prefecture. Aged for 2 years before release. Floral and aromatic, while dry and crisp on the palate due to hard water.

**KID 'Muryozan 35' Junmai Daiginjō** Wakayama 720 ml | 650

Made with Grand Cru Yamada Nishiki rice polished down to 35%, this sake is extremely elegant and savour-worthy. This sake is a tribute to the Muryozan temple where Heiwa Shuzo first started making sake in 1928.

**Nigori** *roughly filtered or 'cloudy'. textured and creamy on the palate, with flavours of coconut and tropical fruit.*

**Hakutsuru 'Sayuri' Nigori** Hyogo **300 ml | 30**  
Japan's No.1 seeling nigori-zake! Melon, coconut with a silky mouthfeel + sharp, crisp finish.

**Kikusui 'Perfect Snow' Nigori Genshu** Niigata **300 ml | 48**  
big, bold + chewy, possessing notes of melon, pear and steamed rice.

**Momokawa 'Pearl' Junmai Ginjō Nigori** Oregon **750 ml | 64**  
the piña colada of sake. notes of coconut, pineapple + banana.

**Dassai '45' Junmai Daiginjō Sasa-Nigori** Yamaguchi **300 ml | 66**  
a quintessential Daiginjō sake from one of Japan's cult breweries. melon, banana + fuji apple lead to savoury jackfruit flavours on the palate.

**Tengumai Yamahai Junmai Nigori** Ishikawa **720 ml | 95**  
This is a savoury + crisp nigori with a silky texture + plenty of body from the sake lees. From Shata Shuzo, renowned for their yamahai sake.

**Yamagata Masamune Junmai Ginjō Usu Nigori** Yamagata **720 ml | 110**  
This elegant nigori has honeydew melon notes, a very light cloudiness and crisp finish from the brewery's hard mountain water.

**Sparkling Sake** *typically low alcohol + off dry.*

**Mio Sparkling Junmai** Nada **300 ml | 40**  
bright + fruity with a refreshing palate of cream soda + fresh stone fruit.

**Hideyoshi 'Lachamte' Sparkling Junmai** Akita **280 ml | 45**  
Lively notes of white peaches and honeysuckle that are underscored by hints of toasted almonds.

**KID Nama Junmai Daiginjō Sparkling** Wakayama **360 ml | 88**  
Bright, fruity and ultra clean! From the award-winning brewery of the year, Heiwa Shuzo.

**Hakkaisan 'AWA' Sparkling Junmai Daiginjō** Niigata **360 ml | 92**  
This is one of the driest sparkling sakes out there made in the Champagne method. Notes of honeydew melon, pear and rice pudding with a crisp, clean finish.

**Ninki Sparkling Junmai Ginjō** Fukushima **720 ml | 115**  
Made using the secondary bottle fermentation that is used to make Champagne. This low alcohol sake has a hint of sweet fruit balanced by lively effervescence.

**Nakano Shuzo Kocha Tea + Ume Sake** Mie **300 ml | 42**  
A unique (and delicious) blend of Darjeeling tea and top grade ume plum sake.

**Choya Black Cane Sugar + Plum Sake** Osaka **720 ml | 82**  
bold yet approachable fruit flavours combined perfectly with laced hints of burnt sugar.

**Tsukasabotan 'Yama Yuzu' Shibori** Kochi **720 ml | 85**  
lively citrus flavours with mandarin spice undertones from high quality yuzu fruit.

**Amabuki 'Matcha Yuzu' Sake** Saga **720 ml | 110**  
Made with match tea from the famous Uji region of Kyoto and high quality yuzu citrus. Luscious and honeyed on the palate.

**Nanbu Bijin 'No Sugar Added' Umeshu** Iwate **720 ml | 110**  
This sake is made with the brewery's own secretive formula to create natural sugars during fermentation and blended with high quality Japanese plums from Wakayama.
